The Sherlock Holmes Stories of Edward D. Hoch 2013-11-26

a dozen marvelous tales of deduction featuring history's most famous detective in a heavily mortgaged country house an heiress's sinister guardian attempts to trap her in a bedroom with a rare indian swamp adder a murder averted only by the timely intervention of sherlock holmes five months after the events of the adventure of the speckled band holmes and watson are called back to stoke moran by a frightened gypsy who claims that the viper has gotten loose again holmes is unsure which poses a greater danger the rumored snake or the possibility that the gypsy is telling lies in these dozen tales short story master edward d hoch resurrects the most brilliant mind in the history of detective fiction in the style of sir arthur conan doyle holmes tangles with circus tigers druidic curses and a pair of christmas killings here is the finest detective of the victorian age recreated by one of the greatest mystery writers of the twentieth century

The Future Is Ours: The Collected Science Fiction of Edward D. Hoch 2016-03-31

edward d hoch was and is the undisputed master of the mystery short story his total output of published short fiction hovers just under 1 000 stories estimates are in the neighborhood of 960 stories hoch pronounced hoke is best remembered for his fair play and impossible crime short stories particularly the series featuring dr sam hawthorne a small town physician who unraveled seemingly impossible problems in 1920s new england his other popular series characters included british intelligence codebreaker jeffrey rand and thief for hire nick velvet while a vast majority of ed hoch's stories were mysteries he enjoyed horror and science fiction of his nine hundred plus output he wrote several handfuls of horror and science fiction stories that appeared in various magazines and anthologies it could be argued that his first published story village of the dead which appeared in the december 1955 issue of the pulp magazine famous detective stories is as much horror as it is a mystery in that story the mass suicide of an entire village is investigated by simon ark a mysterious possibly two thousand year old coptic priest here then are 31 tales of the future the fantastic and the improbable by a master of the craft edward d hoch writer extraordinaire

divdivwhen ancient evil emerges it can only be stopped by a two thousand year old sleuth divdiv ten years ago douglas zadig emerged from the mist on an english moor his clothes tattered his speech slurred and his mind

when a government official dies on the operating table the president calls in the computer cops on venus a radical exile escapes from a maximum security prison pledging to return to washington and assassinate the president transport between earth and the solar colonies is tightly regulated but the exile knows a shortcut the top secret transvection machine an experimental device that could theoretically be used to teleport men from planet to planet vander defoe the tool s creator is busy securing it when he feels a pain in his stomach his appendix is about to explode defoe dies in the operating room during routine computerized surgery and the case falls in the lap of the computer investigation bureau which has jurisdiction over all computer related crimes as the team tries to determine who corrupted the system that killed defoe it finds that in this case all roads lead to venus the transvection machine is the first book in the carl crader mysteries but you may enjoy reading the series in any order

this collection is set in new england during the 1920 s and the 1930 s and features country doctor sam hawthorne who specializes in locked room and other impossible crimes among the 12 stories is the classic tale of a horse and buggy that enter a covered bridge and vanish introduction by the author sam hawthorne chronology and bibliography by marvin lachman

twenty tales of deceit murder and madness from the king of short mysteries they find the third body facedown in the wet grass its head nearly split in half by the axe the psychopath has claimed three in twenty four hours a sickening toll that forces the police department to let the aging inspector fleeming stave off retirement for one more case the cop races to catch the axe maniac before he kills again lest this final assignment become the one that ruins his career there are killers in many of the stories in this collection and a few great detectives too there is a gang of old war buddies who have decided to pick up their guns again a scientist murdered in the wilds of canada two hundred miles from

civilization and a young office worker convinced she's being followed by a man with bushy eyebrows edward d hoch understands crime and knows that evil often lurks behind the kindest smiles

edward d hoch was the most ingenious of modern mystery writers his stories off fair play cluing convincing settings and elaborate sometimes bizarre plots hoch's ladies were often faced with seemingly impossible crimes throat cutting in a locked room shooting of giant cacti murder in a giant hot air balloon stabbing in a shower with no one present poisoning of chinese food as a last meal of a murderer and more ingenious methods that will keep the reader guessing page 4 of cover
