directing the dance legacy of doris humphrey looks inside four of doris humphrey s major choreographic works water study 1928 the shakers 1931 with my red fires 1936 and passacaglia 1938 with an eye to how directorial strategies applied in recent contemporized stagings in the united states and europe could work across the modern and contemporary dance genre author lesley main a seasoned practitioner of doris humphrey choreography stresses to the reader the need to balance respect for classical works from the modern dance repertory with the necessity for fresh directorial strategies to balance between traditional practices and a creative role for the reconstructor drawing upon her own dance experience main s book addresses an area of dance research and practice that is becoming increasingly pertinent as the dancer choreographers of the 20th century modern and contemporary dance are no longer alive to attend to the re stagings of the body of their works insightful and thought provoking directing the dance legacy of doris humphrey calls for the creation of new forms of directorial practice in dance beyond reconstruction the radical new practices it proposes to replace the old are sure to spark debate and fresh thinking across the dance field

in october 2017 four internationally influential practitioners of immersive experiences gathered at the snug harbor cultural center on staten island in new york for a panel discussion on the creation of immersive productions the panel entitled all the world is a stage was part of the future of storytelling festival 2017 fest advertised as the world s leading immersive storytelling event during this discussion each of the four panelists described examples of their work hector harkness associate director of punchdrunk international explained how the company created productions that rip up the rules for the audience so they can go beyond the boundaries of closed environments food technologist experience designer and multimedia artist emilie baltz described inviting audiences to step up to a microphone and use their tongues teeth and lips to play musical popsicles in an installation called popstars jon sands founder of poets in unexpected places revealed how his strategic placement of poets on subway cars across new york city turned commutes into impromptu poetry slams for unsuspecting riders some of whom joined in by improvising their own poetic works justin jb bolognino ceo chief experience officer of meta an experience production company described his commissioning of jon morris artistic director of the brooklyn based windmill factory to design a music festival queue into an experiential artwork entitled right passage the work was a room scale sound and light performance installation involving moving walls that guided festival participants efficiently into the concert venue windmill factory 2017 through their detailed descriptions of how their productions organized the bodies of performers and spectators in space and time the panelists hinted at the presence of choreography in their productions

### **House documents 1886**

a broad range of perspectives from natives and non natives makes this book the most complete account and analysis of the lakota ghost dance ever published a revitalization movement that swept across native communities of the west in the late 1880s the ghost dance took firm hold among the lakotas perplexed and alarmed government agents sparked the intervention of the u s army and culminated in the massacre of hundreds of lakota men women and children at wounded knee in december 1890 although the lakota ghost dance has been the subject of much previous historical study the views of lakota participants have not been fully explored in part because they have been available only in the lakota language moreover emphasis has been placed on the event as a shared historical incident rather than as a dynamic meeting ground of multiple groups with differing perspectives in the lakota ghost dance of 1890 rani henrik andersson uses for the first time some accounts translated from lakota this book presents these indian accounts together with the views and observations of indian agents the u s army missionaries the mainstream press and congress this comprehensive complex and compelling study not only collects these diverse viewpoints but also explores and analyzes the political cultural and economic linkages among them

a consideration of how contemporary art can offer a deeper understanding of selfhood with each one another rachel haidu argues that contemporary art can teach us how to understand ourselves as selves how we come to feel oneness to sense our own interiority
